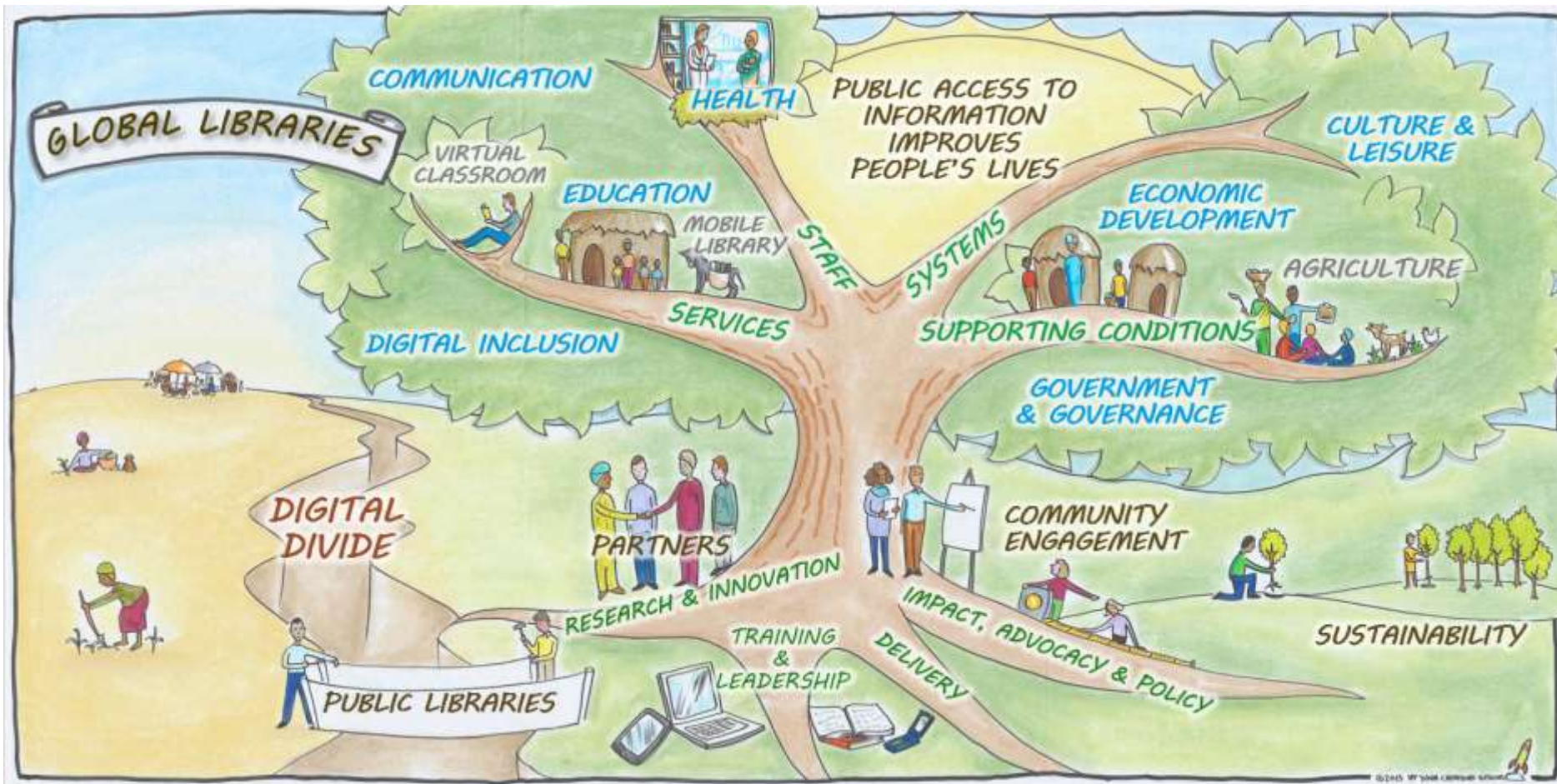

About Libraries for Everyone (LIFE)

- ❑ Started as of February, 2016
- ❑ Duration: 29 Months
- ❑ Willingness and eligibility are prerequisites
- ❑ 32 provinces
- ❑ 163 municipal public libraries

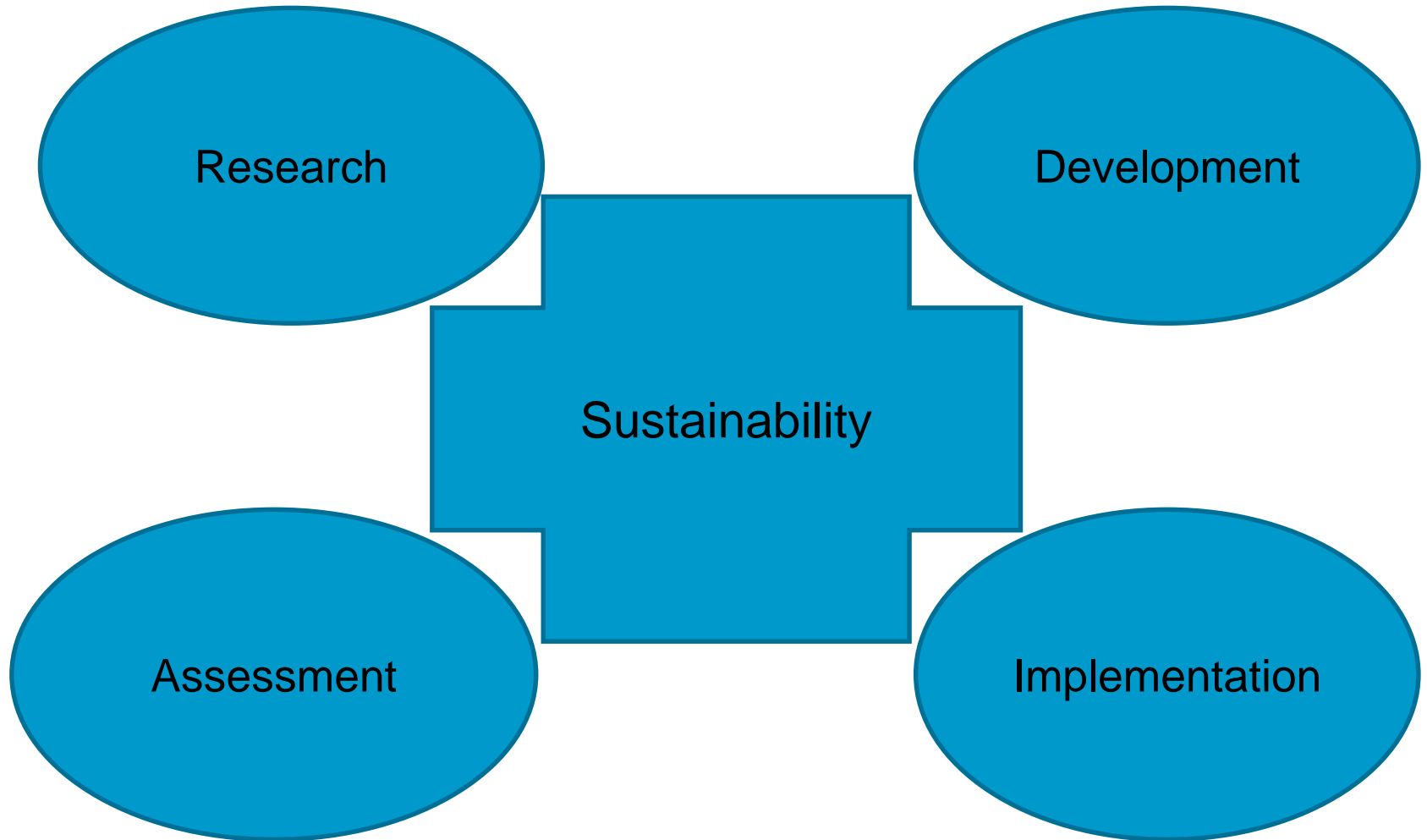

Design of the Project LIFE



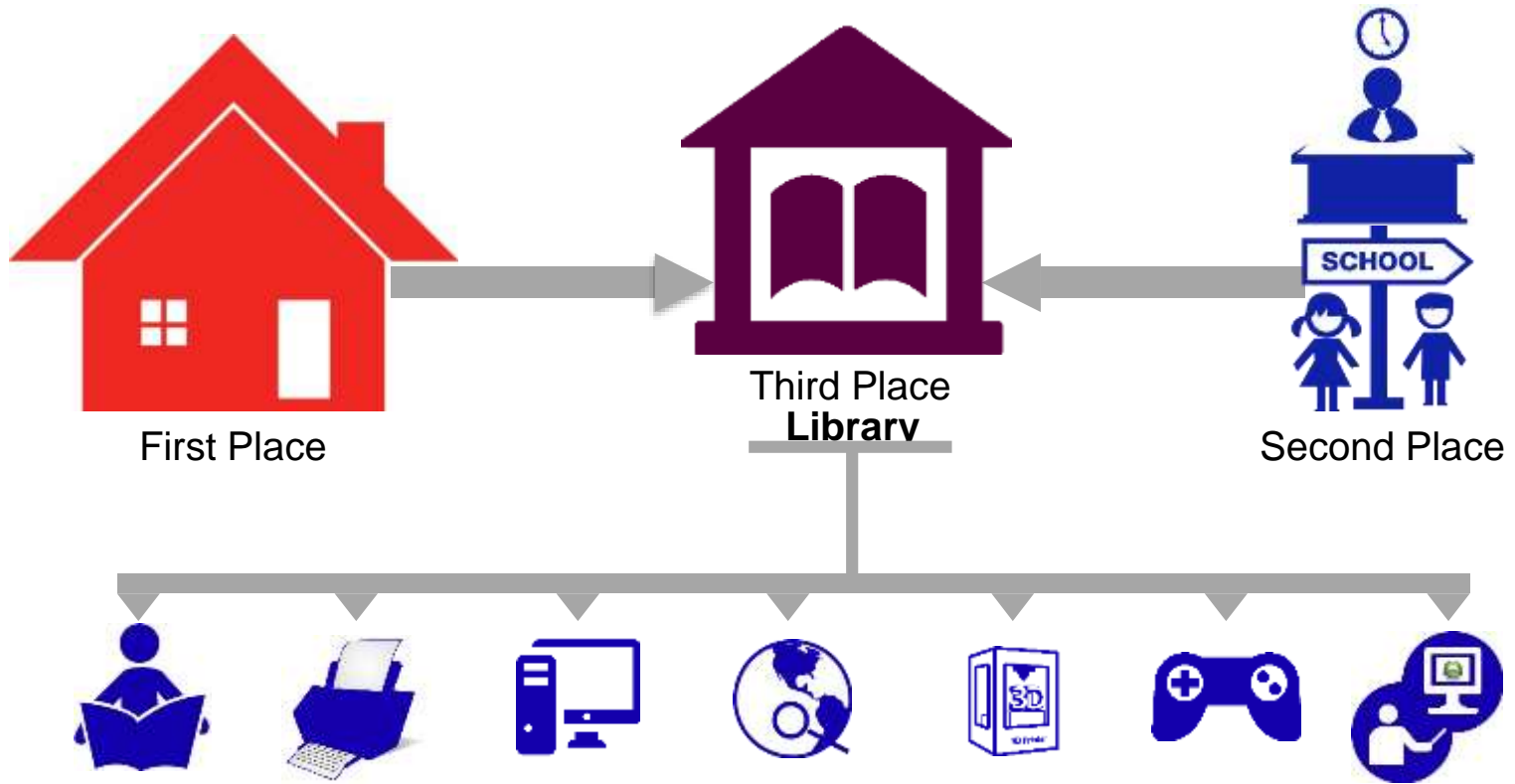
Importance of the Project LIFE

- ❑ Exploring *terra incognita*
- ❑ The most comprehensive library usage studies
 - ❑ 2016 => 140 libraries - 4317 participants
 - ❑ 2017 => 147 libraries - 4566 participants
- ❑ Increase of visibility and awareness in local governments

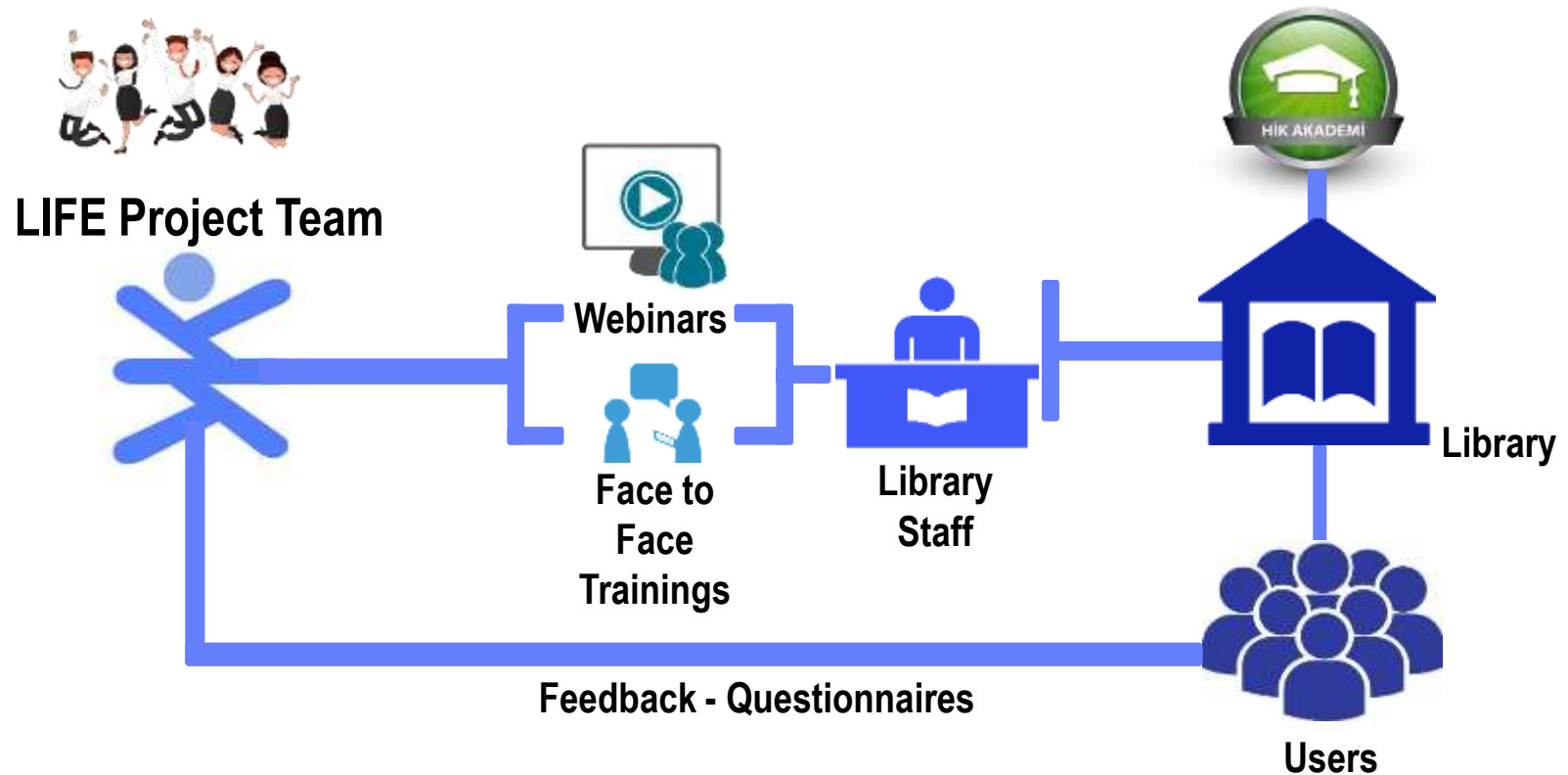
Achievements

- ❑ LIFE bridging the gap

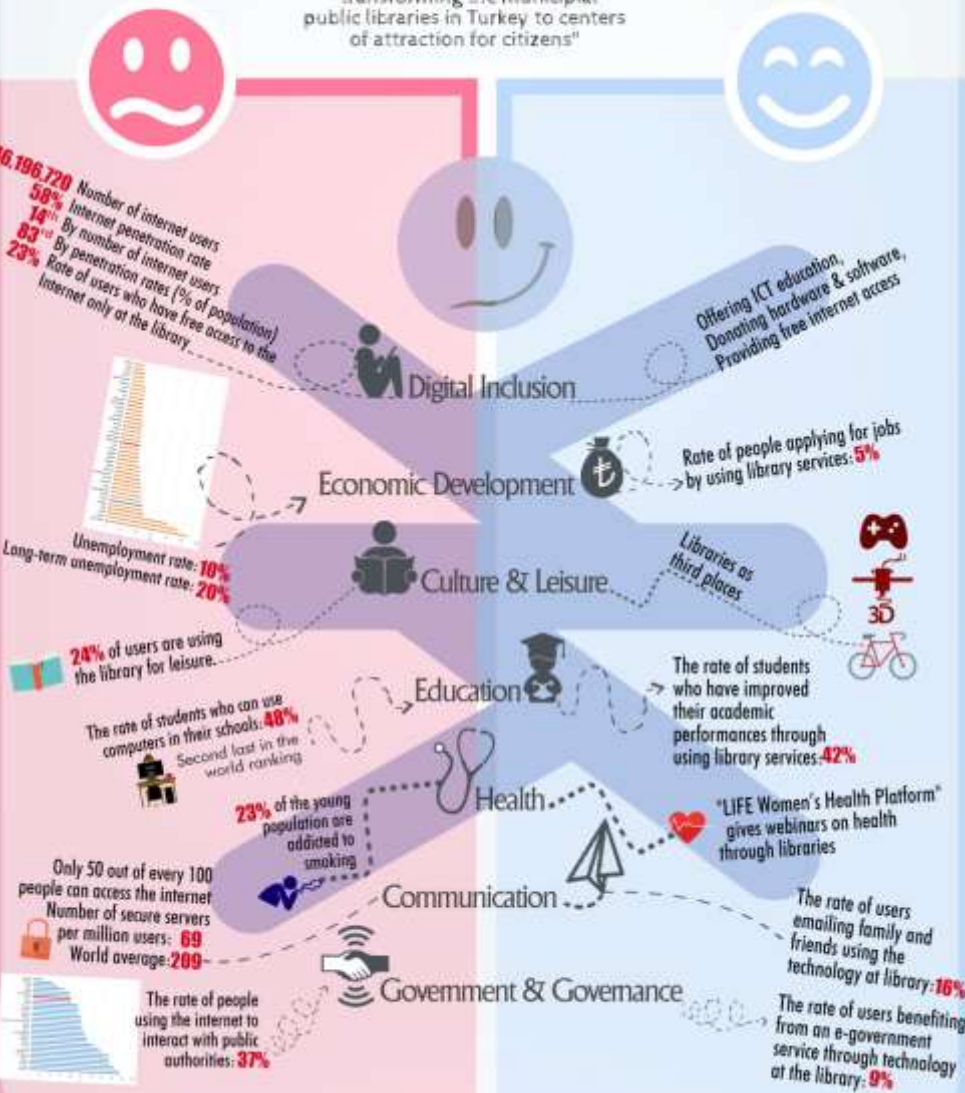

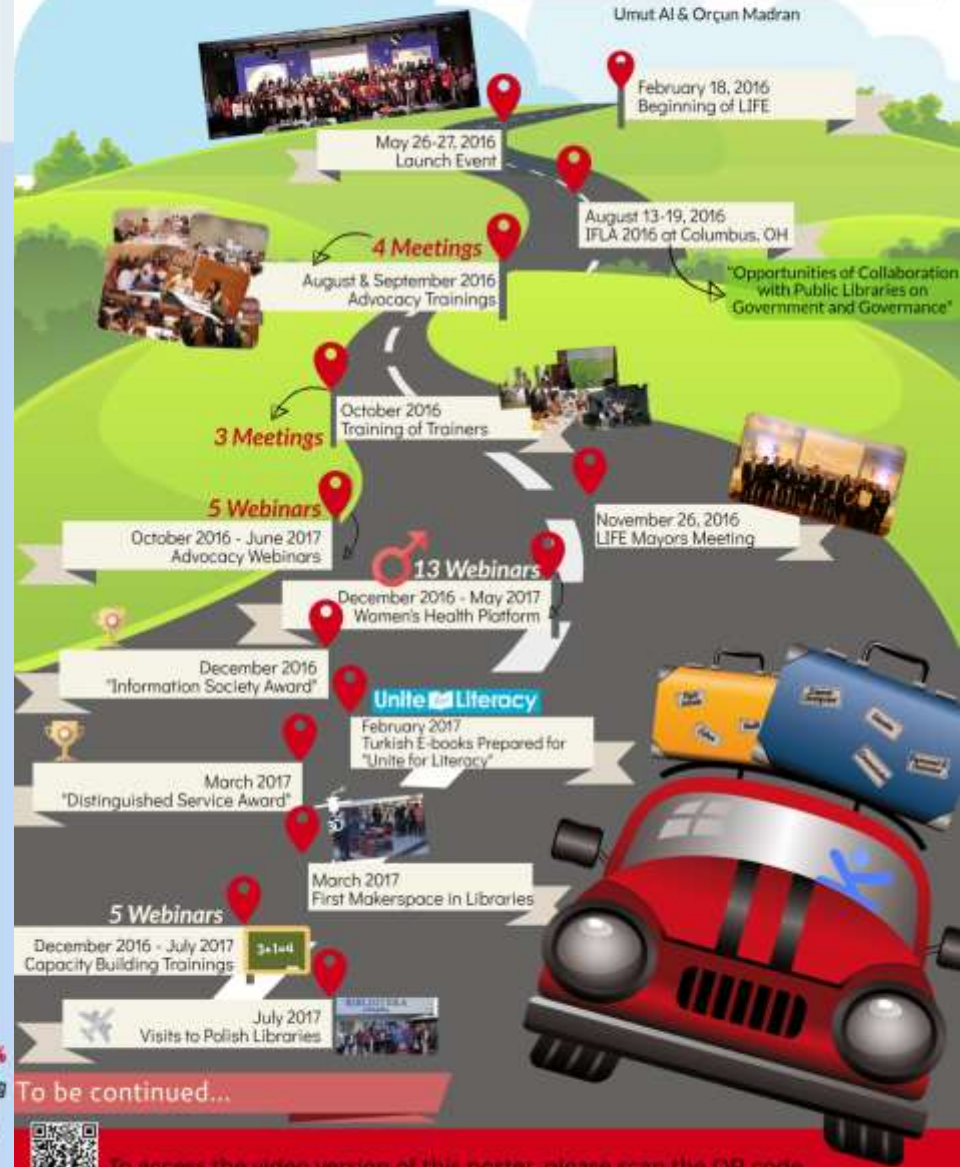
